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REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES of the Diversity Scholarship Program

<u>Eligibility</u>

In order to receive ICAP's Diversity Scholarship, you must:

- Identify as a minority or women
- be a member of the Illinois Coalition of Appraisal professionals in good standing with dues current at the time of application and remain a member in good standing through the utilization of the award (applicants with less than a year's membership may apply as long as an additional narrative is provided explaining why the applicant is a member of the Illinois Coalition of Appraisal professionals).
- have not received this scholarship award within one year preceding the date of your application.

Requested Documentation

Complete signed application/letter of agreement

Elective

Submit a letter of recommendation from an appraisal professional. (This letter is elective, but if submitted will be given additional consideration in the committee's final award decision.)

Awards

This award is good for an annual membership as well as the cost of tuition and course materials of any one seminar offered by the Illinois Coalition of Appraisal professionals, with completion of award within one year of notification date. Award may not be used for any class required by the State of Illinois for disciplinary reasons.

Award Payment

Scholarship money is for membership and course fee only. Course fees are paid with a credit redeemable during online registration.

Application Process

Complete and submit the Application and Agreement prior to the deadline of the year for which you are applying for a scholarship award to the Illinois Coalition of Appraisal Professionals. All portions of the application must be complete, and all information supplied must be accurate.
